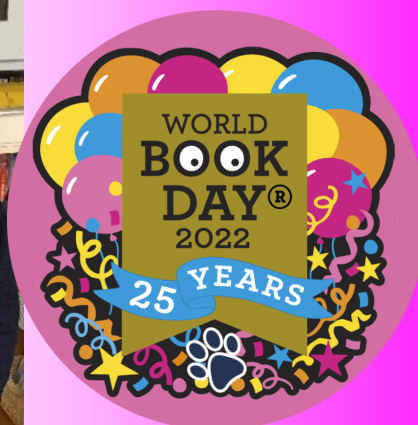


Spring 2- Robin Class
